

Reporting the fresh works of God

Your church is about to embark on a church-wide pilgrimage associated with the book, *The 3 Colors of Your Spirituality*, and on toward a fuller experience of God’s truth, goodness and beauty. The members of your church will take the *Spiritual Style Test* to determine the way in which they each most naturally connect with God and will also come together once a week for a series of themed services at the usual worship time/s.


If you have received this document from your pastor, it may be that he or she would like to empower a *Scribe Team* to report on the fresh work that God is doing in the lives of those in your church. Through interviews and observation, you are challenged to make use of print, verbal presentation, social media, video and any other medium you choose to capture and share the sights, sounds, and sentiments surrounding spiritual transformation in your church.

Spiritual style interview questions

One of the best things to report on during a church-wide pilgrimage is the responses people have to discovering their native and opposite spiritual styles—their strongest and weakest antennas to God. You may choose to make a short video of such an interview or simply write down the transcript. For the sake of variety and getting the big picture of church life, try to capture as many such short interviews as possible.

The following are a few questions that may be of use in such an interview.

1. What is your name?
2. What mostly occupies your time in an average week?
3. Which spiritual style emerged as your native style from the Spiritual Style Test? Did this surprise you? Why? Why not?
4. What people or places through your life do you believe have helped shape your native spiritual style? How so?
5. What recent experience in your life shows your native spiritual style in action and why it brings life to you?
6. Which spiritual styles came out lower for you on your Spiritual Style Test? Did this surprise you? Why? Why not?
7. When you think of your lower spiritual styles, what kind of funny or serious stereotypical pictures come to mind?
8. Which spiritual style are you open to exploring further and how do you think you might go about that in the next little while?



Be sure to start reporting as soon as anything begins to happen with your church-wide pilgrimage so as to create anticipation for the “breaking news” still to come.

Scribe team tools

A smartphone with video capacity and something to make notes on are the main tools you will need for your reporting. Beyond those, there are a number of tools you can draw upon for different purposes...

- *The 3 Colors of Your Spirituality* book could be an important prompt for you in terms of questions and concepts that you might like to explore in interviews. Ask your pastor or church administrator if they can get you a copy.
- All of the **artwork** from *The 3 Colors of Your Spirituality* along with a **PowerPoint master** of the same is freely available from the web site (address to the left) and may be helpful for backdrops or imagery in your reporting.
- If taking video footage of interviews or events during your church’s pilgrimage, it may be convenient to post those freely to **YouTube** for easy sharing with your church.
- If you would like to keep the news, events and discussion around your pilgrimage live and fluent, you may wish to set up a **Church-wide Pilgrimage facebook page** and invite church members to follow it.
